JURIED HIGH SCHOOL ART CONTEST 2010

This year we are hosting our 3rd Annual High School Art Contest for students in grades 9-12 in public, private or home schools. The contest is in coordination with Breathe California's annual Clean Air Awards Luncheon. Winners will be recognized at the awards luncheon.

THEME

The theme of the contest is **Take Action! Care for Your Air.**

All entries should have an interpretation of this theme. Entries will be judged in part on interpretation of the theme.

ENTRY DEADLINES

Intent of Entry form must be submitted by **February 26, 2010**. All art entries (accompanied by signed Entry Form) must be postmarked or hand delivered to 909 12th Street Sacramento, CA 95814 by **March 31, 2010 4:30 p.m.** All entries must be original pieces of work. Breathe California reserves the right to disqualify entries for any reason. Students of all abilities are encouraged to participate.

ENTRIES WILL BE DIVIDED INTO 4 CATEGORIES:

Photography and Video Photography must be submitted ready to hang, unframed or matted, with an overall size not to exceed 11" X 14". Photo entries may not include borrowed, copied or shared images. Video entries must be in DVD format and not more than 3 minutes in length.

Fine Art Entries may be on paper or canvas, not more than 18" X 24". Paint may be acrylic, poster or watercolor.

Ceramics and Sculpture Reused/recycled materials are encouraged. Entries may not be more than 16" high, 16" wide or weigh more than 10 lbs.

Graphic Design Entries must be no larger than 8 ½" x 11" and expressed with advertising or commercial intent.

PRIZES

Entries will be judged by Dr. Phil Hitchcock, Art Professor, Sacramento State and Dan Herrera, Adjunct Professor, Art Institute of California, Sacramento.

The First Place winner in each category will receive a check for \$100. Each prize winner and 1 guest will be invited to attend the Clean Air Awards Luncheon on May 26, 2010 as guests of Breathe California. Students will have the opportunity to meet with judges following the luncheon.
